

RELATIONS WITH SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS

Any request from civic institutions, charitable organizations, or special interest groups which involve such activities as patriotic functions, contests, exhibits, sales of products to and by students, sending promotional materials home with students, graduation prizes, fund-raising, and free teaching materials must be carefully reviewed to ensure that such activities promote student interests without advancing the special interests of any particular group.

It is the policy of the School Board that students, staff members, and Corporation facilities not be used for advertising or promoting the interests of any non-school agency or organization, public or private, without the approval of the Board or its delegated representative; and any such approval, granted for whatever cause or group, shall not be construed as an endorsement of said cause or group by this Board. Administrative guidelines may be developed to implement this policy.

Upon request by a youth organization listed in Title 36 of the United States Code that has an educational purpose and promotes patriotism and civic involvement, School will provide at least one (1) time each school year, a day and time which may be during the school day for the representatives of the organization to provide information to students on school property. Schools will conduct an expanded criminal history check of a representative of an organization before the representative may provide information to students.
