

H225 - DISTRICT-SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS

The School Board appreciates the efforts of all organizations whose objectives are to enhance the educational experiences of District students, to help meet the educational needs of students, and/or provide extra educational benefits not provided for, at the time, by the Board. In using the name of the District or its schools and in organizing a group whose identity derives from a school(s) of this District, the parental organization thereby shares responsibility with this Board for the welfare of participating students.

These needs may be educational to parents and/or children. In addition to parents, membership shall be available to the District's professional staff.

Any new District support organization desiring to use the name or good offices of the District must obtain the approval of the Superintendent as a prerequisite to organizing.

Each approved District support organization shall work within the appropriate school setting and in cooperation with the principals and other staff members. Each group will submit its bylaws to the Superintendent for approval and shall abide by the policies of the Board and the guidelines established by the Superintendent.
